Mediacom Communications Boosts Xstream Internet Speeds

MEDIACOM PARK, NY – MAY 14, 2024 – [Mediacom Communications](#) today announced that the company is making significant speed enhancements to several of its most popular Xstream Internet services. Beginning May 17th, new and existing customers will be able to take advantage of the following speed increases:

- **Xstream Internet 100 will become Xstream Internet 250** – Speeds jump from 100 Mbps down to 250 Mbps down, a 150% increase.
- **Xstream Internet 300 will become Xstream Internet 500** – Speeds climb from 300 Mbps down to 500 Mbps down, a 67% increase.

Mediacom has also replaced its Connect2Compete Plus service with a new and improved low-cost broadband plan called [Xstream Connect](#) which offers speeds of 100 Mbps down by 20 Mbps up. Priced at just \$14.99 per month plus modem rental, if applicable, Xstream Connect provides qualifying households an affordable pathway to the internet. Mediacom is further enhancing this program by allowing customers enrolled in the Xstream Connect program to add landline phone service for just \$5 per month. Xstream Connect is available to any household in Mediacom's service territory that participates in the National School Lunch Program, SNAP, Medicaid, Federal Public Housing Assistance, SSI, WIC, or certain other federal programs.

“As media and entertainment consumption continues to shift and accelerate online, access to fast and reliable internet service has become more important than ever,” said Tapan Dandnaik, Mediacom's SVP of Operations, Product Strategy and Consumer Experience. “From our fiber-rich network outside the home to our fast, reliable, and secure next generation Wi-Fi inside the home, our advanced services have been designed to seamlessly evolve as consumer demand grows. These significant speed changes are just the latest example.”

All of the enhanced plans announced today are in addition to the Xstream 1 Gig Unlimited services Mediacom offers across its national fiber-rich network and the Xstream 1 Gig Symmetrical Unlimited and Xstream 2 Gig Unlimited services the company is continuing to launch in a growing number of markets.
