Cable TV Pioneers Call for Nominations to Mark Historic 60th Anniversary

Nominees should have a minimum of 20 years in the cable and broadband industry and exemplify:

- Distinguished and lasting contributions to the cable and broadband industry
- Leadership that reflects the organization's values of integrity, mentorship and service
- A record of advancing innovation and strengthening the communities the industry serves

Selections will be made in accordance with the organization's established nomination and review process.

Inductees will be formally recognized at the 60th Annual Cable TV Pioneers Induction Ceremony in Atlanta, Georgia, on September 28, 2026. The new Pioneers will be joining a distinguished roster of industry leaders whose collective work has defined and propelled the modern cable and broadband landscape.
