



- Consultation Requirements**
- All Developments
 - All buildings, structures, and works exceeding 10 metres in height (32.8 feet).
 - All buildings, structures, and works exceeding 15 metres in height (49.2 feet).
 - All buildings, structures, and works exceeding 45 metres in height (147.6 feet).
 - All buildings, structures, and works exceeding 90 metres in height (295.3 feet).
 - All buildings, structures, and works exceeding 150 metres in height (492.1 feet).
 - All buildings, structures, and works exceeding 300 metres in height (984.2 feet).

- All applications for development likely to attract birds, within 13km of the aerodrome. For example:
 - Areas of water such as reservoirs, lakes, ponds and wetlands including Sustainable Urban Drainage Systems (SUDS).
 - Sites being used for the handling of waste
 - Nature reserves or bird sanctuaries
 - Sewage disposal plants
 - Mineral extraction & quarrying
 - Large landscaping schemes with a high percentage of berry/fruit bearing species
 - Large areas of tree planting
 - Buildings with large areas of flat or shallow pitched roofs
 - Golf courses
 - Large areas of earth works
- Any planning applications that include proposals for solar energy in relation to non-domestic installations, within 6km of the aerodrome.
- Any planning applications that include proposals for wind turbines, within 30km of the aerodrome.

Any developments that include chimneys/flues or cooling towers that could emit exhaust plumes.

- All other applications connected with an aviation use, for example:
- Development at an existing aerodrome
 - Creation of a new aerodrome
 - The use of a site for the purposes of flight or as a drop zone for parachuting
