We are developing a roadmap to detail how we will achieve net zero for our own emissions and are working closely with our partners to influence reductions in their carbon emissions.

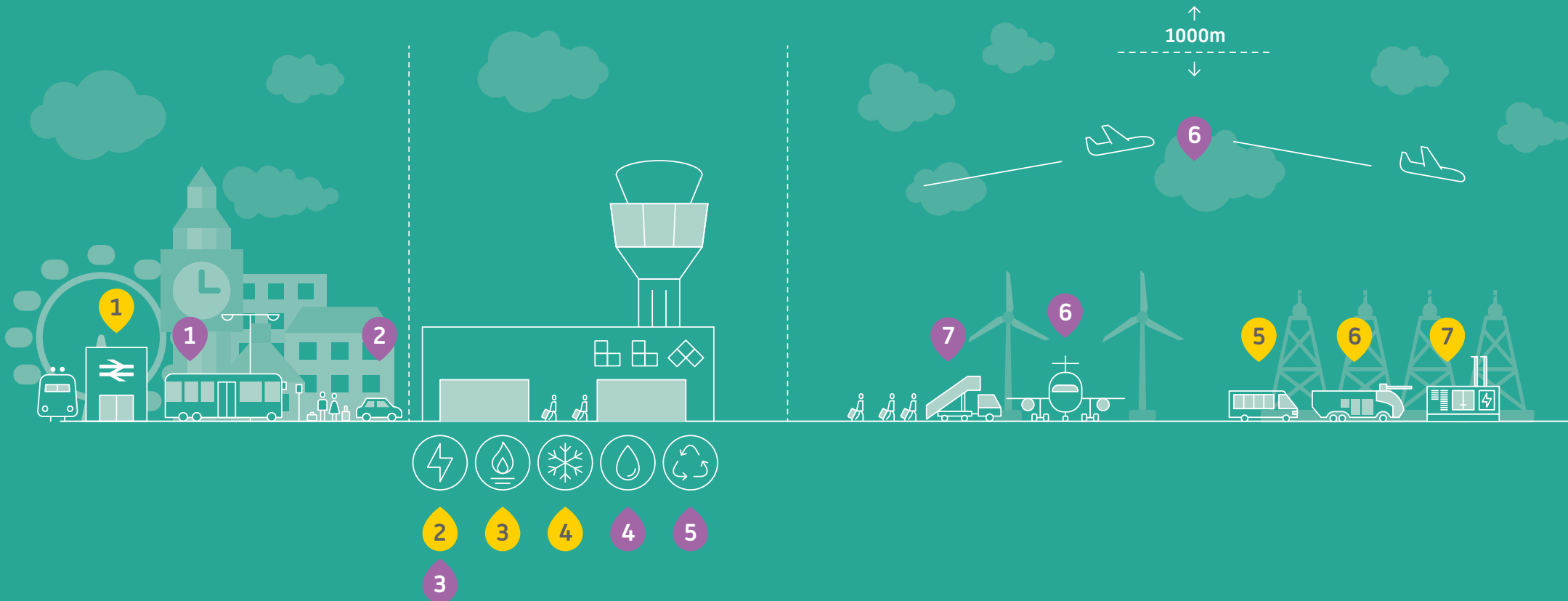

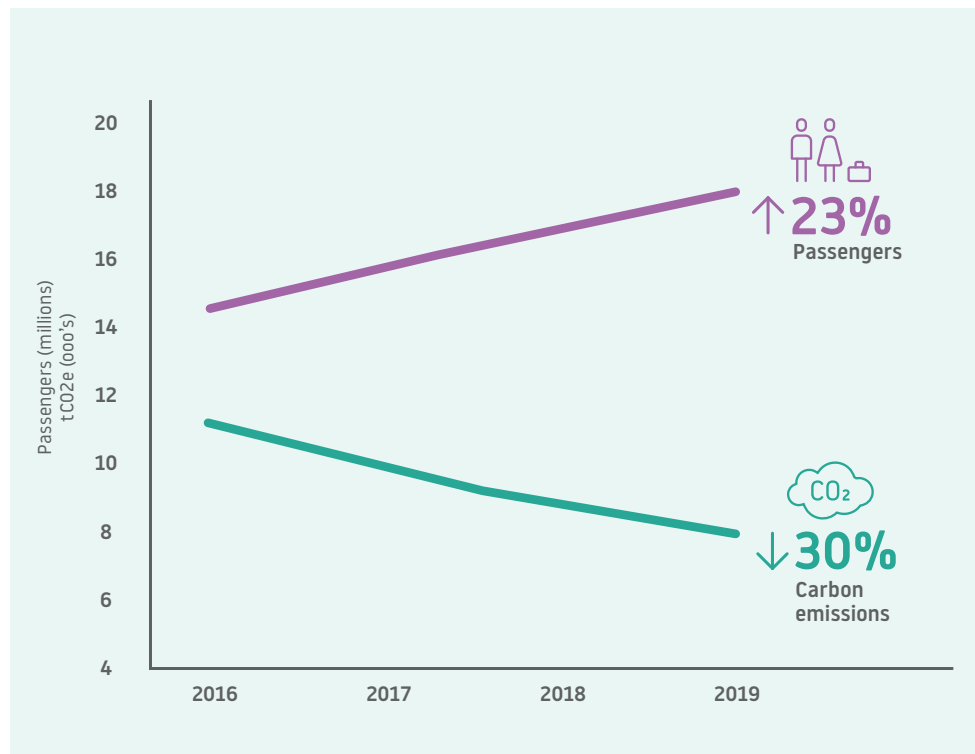

# Our carbon journey

Between 2016 and 2019 we have reduced our airport carbon emissions by 30% despite a 23% increase in passenger numbers **breaking the link between growth in passenger numbers and carbon emissions.**
