## **Our emissions**




## Our carbon journey

Between 2016 and 2019 we have reduced our airport carbon emissions by 30% despite a 23% increase in passenger numbers breaking the link between growth in passenger numbers and carbon emissions.



We are working closely with our partners and have developed a Stakeholder Engagement Plan which outlines future programmes to reduce our partners' carbon emissions.


