THE SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATE

Ideal candidates will have experience in aircraft valeting; however this is not essential and full training will be provided.

The role is often demanding and the successful candidate should be flexible, able to work under pressure and have the ability to prioritise whilst remaining calm and continuing to set a professional example to your team.

Applicants should also have an enthusiastic, willing personality with a sense of humour and the ability to work on their own initiative. Good communication skills combined with courtesy and integrity are essential.

Computer literacy is also an essential requirement.

The role is an active role and therefore you need to also be physically fit to fulfil the job requirements. You will also be required to work in all weather conditions.

You will need to have a 5-year checkable history in order to obtain an airport ID pass, and a full UK driving license is essential.

In accordance with Home Office guidance successful candidates will be required to evidence their right to work in the UK before commencement of employment. We do not hold a licence to sponsor this role under the Skilled Worker route. Candidates must therefore hold the right to work in the UK without employer sponsorship.
