FOREWORD



WELCOME TO OUR COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT STRATEGY, COVERING THE FIVE YEAR PERIOD 2013-2017

For 75 years, London Luton Airport has been an important landmark in Luton and has played a major part in the lives of many local people. Since the mid 1990s in particular, the Airport has grown rapidly and is now the fifth largest in the UK. It is also the single largest centre of employment, generating over 8,000 jobs and contributing over £1 billion to the local and regional economy each year.

We recognise that such success is sustained on a foundation of strong relationships between London Luton Airport and its communities. To ensure these relationships flourish we are committed to contributing passionately and thoughtfully to the social, economic and environmental life of our communities in practical and valuable ways.

In 2008, we set out our first formal Community Engagement Strategy covering the period 2008-2012. This strategy focused on three key action areas - 'A Better Environment', 'A Vibrant Neighbourhood' and 'A Growing Economy'. We are proud of the progress we have made over the course of the past five years by introducing a range of processes, initiatives and projects to deliver against annual objectives. Highlights of the Airport's progress between 2008-2012 include:

- Over £160,000 raised for local charities through the Airport's charity partnership programme;
- 70% of young people taking part in London Luton's 'Get into Airports' programme with The Prince's Trust found employment as a direct result;
- £180,000 invested in the local community through the Airport's Community Trust Fund;
- More than 300 local businesses involved in the Airport's Meet the Buyer events;
- An 88% increase in the volume of waste recycled in 2012 compared to 2008;
- Progressive reduction in night time noise and the introduction of one of the lowest violation limits in the UK.

Our new community engagement strategy aims to build on this success, by setting out a clear approach for how we will direct our activities to facilitate long term community development and meet the needs of our neighbours. We also show how we will manage the impact of our operations on those communities whilst ensuring the wider benefits are shared with those located nearest to the Airport.



We look forward to working alongside our communities to deliver against the vision of our strategy.


INSPIRING YOUNG PEOPLE



Commit £50,000 to the London Luton Airport Community Trust Fund




Work in partnership with local educational providers to deliver a numeracy challenge to 1,000 local primary school pupils
