Features such as the second-generation vibration suppression function, "One-Touch Tuning" or automatic real-time adjustment of servo parameters during operation accelerates commissioning and guarantees positioning with maximum precision and safety based on international standards. "This also shortens machine cycle times, for example," explains Oliver Giertz, Product Manager Servo/Motion & Robotics for EMEA region at Mitsubishi Electric.

User-friendly and space-saving

All <u>MR-J4</u> series controllers are equipped with various predictive and preventative maintenance functions. The Condition Based Maintenance

(CBM) functionality allows early detection of changes in machine vibration and friction which enables replacement of mechanical drive components such as ball screws, belts and gears before they fail. The indication of maintenance needs in advance leads to increased machine capacity by helping avoid downtime and reducing maintenance time which all leads to improved productivity and product quality. "Its flexibility and user-friendliness; space-saving design, predictive maintenance functions and excellent price versus performance ratio make the MR-J4 a safe investment for our customers." says Oliver Giertz.
