### PRIVACY STATEMENT ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA- CONTACT FORM

# 1. Purposes and Legal Grounds of the Processing of Personal Data

Articles 5 and 6 of the <u>Personal Data Protection Law No. 6698</u> ("**the Law**") regulate the legal grounds for the processing of personal data. Within the scope of using the contact form, the purposes and legal reasons for the processing of your personal data are as follows:

### 2. Processed Personal Data

Within the scope of the purposes specified in this statement, your identity, contact, transaction security, legal transaction and feedback, question, suggestion, request, and complaint information is processed.

#### 3. Sharing Personal Data with Third Parties

Your personal data is shared with suppliers, authorized institutions and organizations, and group companies established Turkey and abroad to accomplish purposes stated in the heading of **"1. Purposes and Legal Grounds of the Processing of Personal Data".** While sharing your personal data with third parties, compliance with the rules of the Law regarding the transfer of personal data is ensured.

## 4. Methods and Legal Grounds of Personal Data Collection

Your personal data is collected by automated and partially automated methods through a form filled in electronically. Your personal data is processed based on the legal grounds specified under Article 5 of the Law of *the establishment, execution, or protection of a right, the fulfillment of legal obligations, the necessity of processing for our legitimate interests,* and *your explicit consent*.

### 5. Data Subject Rights
