You notice that your patient is:

- Asking for repetitions
- Leaning in to listen
- Relying on a companion to assist with understanding
- Having more difficulty hearing than in previous appointments
- Over age 75 and has not had an audiological evaluation in the past 3 years

Your patient reports:

- Hearing and understanding difficulty
- Trouble hearing in a loud or busy environments
- Subjective tinnitus
