Here is some information showing how the activities in the booklet map to each part of Arts Award Discover.

Remember that children and young people achieve Arts Award Discover by keeping a record of what they have done for each of the three parts of the award:

- ▶ Part A: discover the arts
- ▶ Part B: find out
- ▶ Part C: share

The booklet is just a starting point: if you want bigger pages or more of them, or to use film or audio clips go ahead! Just make sure you keep them all together ready for the final assessment.

Your Arts Award adviser Toolkit has all the information you will need to make sure that the children you're working with complete Discover.

Page 2: Discovering art in every day life	Part A: Understanding how the arts encompass a range of art forms; understanding how art forms connect to their own lives
Page 3: Take part in different arts activities	Part A: participation in a range of arts activities
Page 4: This is me taking part in arts activities	Part A: participation in a range of arts activities
Pages 5 and 6: Find out about artists and their work	Part B: find out about artists and their work
Page 7: Real live artists	Part B: find out about artists and their work
Page 8: Are there any artists in your family or class?	Part B: showing all sorts of people are artists
Page 9: Share what you discovered	Part C: share what they have enjoyed and learned and record how they shared it
