	<b>MFP</b> Market Facilitation Program	Selected commodities negatively impacted by trade disruptions	<i>farmers.gov/manage/mfp</i>	Total of \$8.59 billion paid in 2018 and \$14.5 billion in 2019
	<b>WHIP+</b> Wildfire and Hurricane Indemnity Program Plus	Producers who experienced losses from hurricanes, wildfires and other qualifying natural disasters including 2019 floods	<i>farmers.gov/recover/whip-plus</i>	\$3 billion for disasters that occurred in 2018 and 2019
	<b>PLC</b> Price Loss Coverage	Producers who made the election in 2019	<i>farmers.gov/arc-plc</i>	Payments issued when commodity less than reference price
	<b>ARC</b> Agriculture Risk Coverage	Producers who made the election in 2019	<i>farmers.gov/arc-plc</i>	Income support tied to historical base acres, and county or individual farm revenue
	<b>Crop insurance</b>	More than 100 commodities covered	<i>rma.usda.gov</i>	Nearly \$8.1 billion in crop insurance indemnity payments in 2019
	<b>CRP</b> Conservation Reserve Program	Producers who farm highly erodible land, with acreage cap at 27 million acres by 2023	<i>fsa.usda.gov/crp</i>	Annual outlays at \$2 billion per year, with average rental rate at \$82 per acre
