Completed applications are due no later than <u>February 1</u>. A four-person judging committee will evaluate the nominations and judge each candidate by the middle of March. Winning candidates will be contacted in late March or early April.

The requirements

Along with a completed application, each nominee should provide a minimum of **four** letters of recommendation. These letters can come from other farmers, bankers, veterinarians, nutritionists, Extension personnel, community leaders or others who can attest to the nominee's qualifications for the award. News clippings and photos can also strengthen the application.

The award

The Master Farmer Award is the most prestigious honor bestowed to a farmer. Less than 1% of all farmers in the Mid-Atlantic region have been recognized as Master Farmers. Winners of the Master Farmer Award will receive a plaque and will be invited to attend the Mid-
