563,376 passengers made their way through Keflavík Airport in March, marking -6,8% decrease compared to March last year, worth noting that easter traffic was in March last year compared to April this year.

In total over 1.5 million passengers have travelled through KEF Airport in the first quarter of the year, which is similar to same period last year.

In March, 20 airlines operated flights to/from 66 destinations. The most popular destination in number of passengers are London, Copenhagen, Paris, New York and Amsterdam.

This month the route development team at KEF travelled to Routes Asia in Perth, Australia. This is the second time the team attends Routes Asia in line with the aim of getting a direct service between Iceland and Asia. The conference brings us one step closer to that goal.
