We realise the importance of mental wellbeing and have curated a stunning collective of wallpaper & fabrics that are designed to calm


and ground interior spaces.








$Recipe\ for$

HEART PANCAKES

Ingredients

150g self-raising flour

3 tbsp caster sugar

1 egg

150ml milk

1 tsp baking powder

Heart shaped cookie cutter

Method

- 1 Mix together the flour and sugar in a bowl.
- 2 Add the egg, milk and baking powder then combine until a thick texture is formed.
- 3 Add the batter to a medium-high heat pan and flip.
- 4 Once the pancake is cooked on both sides, remove from the pan and once cool cut into a heart shape with the cookie cutter. (For an added challenge, try placing the cutter in the pan and placing the batter directly in to mould to shape whilst cooking)





To Drink BE MY VALENTINE COCKTAIL

Ingredients

Tall cocktail tumbler

Grenadine

Fresh strawberries

Cranberry juice

Vodka

Lemonade

Method

- 1 First step is to grab the perfect cocktail tumbler to follow the aesthetic of our "Be My Valentine", any tall cocktail glass will work perfectly for this.
- Once you've picked your glass, pour in a generous amount of Grenadine into the hottom
- 3 Next thinly slice a couple of strawberries, before cutting a small triangle at the root to create a love heart like shape.
- 4 Fill your glass with ice, placing your strawberries to the inside edge.
- 5 Add 100ml of cranberry juice before adding a dash of vodka to the mix.
- 6 Lastly, fill the remainder of the glass with lemonade, garnish with another slice of strawberry and enjoy!


