# IN THE STUDIO WITH Victoria

### WHERE DID THE INSPIRATION COME FROM?

In keeping with our trend "Craft Work" Doty combined the exquisite details of our studios hand sketched tree studies and the intricate etchings of Piranesi. We were particularly attracted to Piranesi's style as he had focused on fictious labyrinths and fantasy dreamscape classical landscapes.

#### HOW LONG DID THE DESIGN TAKE TO COMPLETE?

It took over 4 weeks to hand draw from start to finish. From the beginning stages of the outline drawing to every little detail featured in the design. We then passed this over to the digital design team who spent time converting into a mural and wallpaper!

### WHAT TECHNIQUE WAS USED TO CREATE THE MURAL?

I worked with a range of fine liners to capture every detail of the hand drawn design. Bringing the idea to life after taking inspiration from historic buildings around Lancashire where our Head Office is based!


#### WHAT'S YOUR FAVOURITE PART OF THE DESIGN PROCESS?

My favourite part of the design process for me is getting the right composition, I love to see how all the different sections come together and form the design.









# Recipe for CHOCOLATE CAKE

#### ${Cake\atop Ingredients}$

200g golden caster sugar

200g unsalted butter, softened plus extra for the tins

4 large eggs

200g self-raising flour

2 tbsp cocoa powder

1 tsp baking powder

½ tsp vanilla extract

2 tbsp milk

#### Buttercream Ingredients

100g milk chocolate, chopped


200g butter, softened

400g icing sugar

5 tbsp cocoa powder 2 tbsp milk

#### Method

- In a large bowl, beat together the caster sugar, unsalted butter, large eggs, self-raising flour, cocoa powder, baking powder, vanilla extract, milk and a pinch of salt until pale and then pour into a greaseproof tin baking tin.
- 2 Bake for 20 mins or until a skewer inserted into the centre of the cake comes out clean, then leave to cool.
- 3 For the buttercream, put the chopped milk chocolate into a heatproof bowl and melt in the microwave, stirring every 30 secs. Leave the melted chocolate to cool for 5 mins.
- 4 Mash the softened butter and icing sugar together with a fork, Sift in the cocoa powder with a pinch of salt and pour in the melted chocolate and milk. Mix again until smooth, then decorate!



## LET'S DECORATE

Chocolate Shard Ingredients

50g dark chocolate
25g milk chocolate
25g white chocolate

#### Method

- Melt the dark chocolate and pour it onto a tray lined with baking parchment or foil. Now melt the milk and white chocolate and drizzle them over the dark chocolate before it sets.
- Shake the tray gently to level the mixture then leave to set somewhere cool. Chop into shards.

# To Drink ELDERTON ESPRESSO MARTINI

#### Ingredients

11/2 ounces (3 tablespoons) Kahlúa

1 ounce espresso

11/2 ounces chocolate liquor

#### Method

1 Brew the espresso and let cool.

While cooling add a chocolate

- 2 rim to your glass then add the ingredients into a shaker with ice.
- **3** Pour, serve and enjoy!


