### FUND OBJECTIVE

The fund aims to provide long-term capital growth and income by tracking the performance of companies listed on the FTSE/JSE Capped Shareholder Weighted All Share Index (J433).

### WHO IS THIS FUND FOR?

This fund is suitable for investors who want to grow capital over the long term by tracking the FTSE/JSE Capped Shareholder Weighted All Share Index. The investor can tolerate stock market volatility.

### INVESTMENT MANDATE

The fund tracks the FTSE/JSE Capped Shareholder Weighted All Share Index as closely as possible and invests in instruments included in the index. The portfolio is tailored to match the performance of the FTSE/JSE Capped Shareholder Weighted All Share Index. The fund may gain exposure to offshore assets listed on the index. Derivatives may be used for efficient portfolio management purposes.

### REGULATION 28 COMPLIANCE

The fund aims to achieve long-term inflation-beating growth, and therefore may hold a higher allocation to equities than what is allowed in terms of Regulation 28 of the Pension Funds Act. This fund is therefore not Regulation 28 compliant.

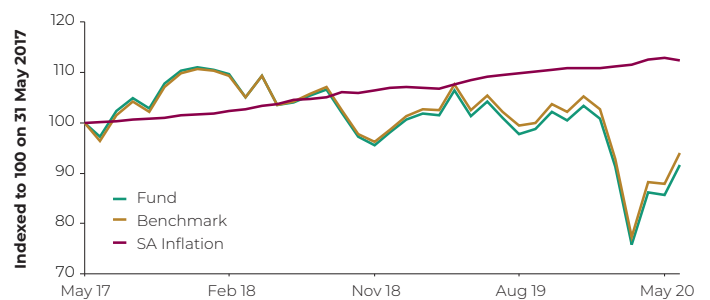

## FUND COMMENTARY

The Old Mutual Capped SWIX Index Fund tracks the FTSE/JSE Capped SWIX All Share Index and its holdings replicate the constituents that make up this benchmark. At month-end, the benchmark sector allocation was as follows:

Cash exposure is kept as low as possible to give investors the full benefit of being invested in equities. Investment flows are matched with the corresponding market transactions on a daily basis to ensure that the performance of the fund is in line with its benchmark. Futures contracts are used, when appropriate, to minimise trading costs and gain exposure to equities.

Long-term investors choose this fund because they are looking for a pure equity fund and are cost-conscious. Investors seeking consistency can

use this fund as their core portfolio strategy and assign smaller portions to other investment vehicles that aim to outperform the market.

The FTSE/JSE Capped SWIX Index returned 6.98% for the month of June 2020. The best performing sectors for the quarter were basic materials and technology with returns of 41.30% and 24.53%, respectively. The worst performing sector was consumer services with a return of 5.00% for the quarter. The FTSE/JSE Capped SWIX Index returned 21.64% for the quarter and -10.78% for the year ended June 2020.

The fund rebalances once every quarter in line with the index. There was one constituent deletion from and there were no constituent additions to the index for the quarter. The rebalanced index is effective as at open on Monday 22 June 2020.

Some of the top individual stock performers in the index for the quarter ending June 2020 were Sasol Ltd, DRDGOLD Ltd and Harmony Gold Mining Co Ltd with returns of 258.00%, 163.20% and 81.70% respectively, while some of the main detractors were RMB Holdings Ltd, Intu Properties PLC and Zeder Investments Ltd with returns of -96.70%, -70.70% and -47.50% respectively.

### EXIT FEE:

Old Mutual Unit Trusts will charge an exit fee of 2.30% if exiting within 2 weeks of entry and reserves the right to charge this fee if exiting within 6 months of entry. The exit fee will not apply to investments in the fund via the Old Mutual Unit Trusts Tax-Free Investment.
